- Support the production engineering team as and when required.

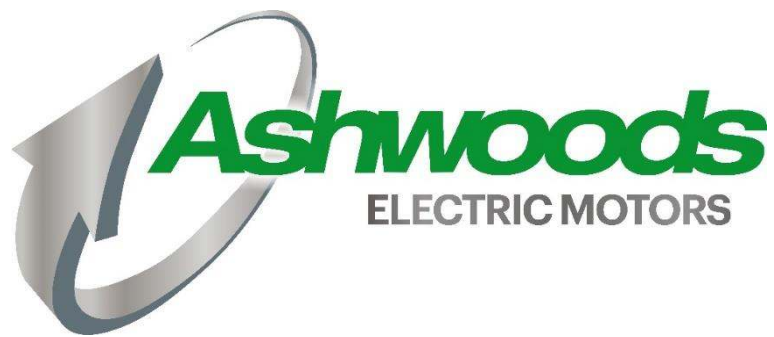
Desired qualifications, skills and experience
